Group Adult Foster Care

Group Adult Foster Care (Medicaid Assisted Living) is a comprehensive service for individuals (22 years or older) with disabilities or chronic medical conditions who must have daily assistance in order to remain safely in their homes.

Services

- Personal care services on a five to seven day schedule
- Homemaking
- Home Delivered Meals
- Meal preparation
- Transportation
- Grocery shopping
- Adult day health program
- Care monitoring by a Registered Nurse and a Case Manager

Eligibility

- MassHealth (Medicaid) participant or eligible for MassHealth
- Live in subsidized housing
- Need daily assistance with tasks such as bathing, dressing, toileting, meal preparation, and ambulation
- Physician's approval for program admission

Fees

- Services are state-subsidized
